

To step back and think about what you are doing

- What is happening?
- Why is it happening?
- Is it good or bad? And what am I basing the judgement on?

To learn and improve

- What could be done different / better? How?
- What is the impact of the change?




Reflective Practice Introduction video, using the 4R model of reflection









